



> euroAtlantic airways and terraBrasil, the best of Brazil is Back!

euroAtlantic airways (EAA), a company founded by Tomaz Metello in which Grupo Pestana (GP) is a shareholder, becomes the sole charter company in the national market to fly to the traditionally elected destinations of Porto Seguro and Maceió in the northeastern region of Brazil, after operations were announced under the brand terraBrasil owned by Sonhando S.A, where EAA holds a participation.

The Chairman and CEO of Atlantic airways, Tomaz Metello, followed by another executive director of Sonhando, Eduardo Pinto Lopes, stated that “EAA launched charter operations to João Pessoa, a destination in Paraíba, on the 20th September 2000, after fighting a strong battle with the authorities and flagship companies of both countries. terraBrasil, one of the brands owned by our tourist operator, Sonhando, is now resuming tourist flights to Porto Seguro and Maceió, since Brazil has always been an elected destination for us. Portugal and Brazil are two nations sharing a common language and history. But flying between both countries is, however, still need to further improve knowledge, reunite the peoples of sister nations and promote the pleasure of going on holidays while still speaking Portuguese”, said Tomaz Metello. “Both destinations have exceptional beaches, unbeatable leisure possibilities, and a wide cultural offer which includes handicraft, cuisine, and lively history lessons for the youngsters to revive the same journey set out 500 years ago”, added Eduardo Pinto Lopes.

euroAtlantic airways is due to operate every Saturday from the 31st July until the 28th of August 2010, and is available in all Portuguese Travel Agencies. Operational details are displayed on the website www.terrabrasil.pt (<http://www.terrabrasil.pt/>), where reservations can be simulated and an Agency of choice can be selected.

About euroAtlantic: euroAtlantic airways is company founded by Tomaz Metello, its major shareholder. The company’s fleet is made of American airplanes, including one Boeing B777-200ER (Triple Seven), the only one to operate in the Iberian Peninsula. Negotiations are now ongoing for the acquisition of a second series 777 airplane, a fleet of four Boeing 767-300ER and two Boeing 757-200, one Lockheed Tristar L1011-500 and one B767-ER BDSF (Bedek Special Freighter). euroAtlantic airways also holds the majority of the capital and the management of STP AIRWAYS, São Tomé e Príncipe’s flagship airliner.
