



**> euroAtlantic airways announces 2007 results**

euroAtlantic airways (EAA), held by Tomáz Metello and by Grupo Pestana (GP), will announce, at Hotel Pestana Palace, in Lisbon, on May 27, 2008 (Tuesday), at 11:30 p.m., the results of the 2007 fiscal year. The founder and Chairman of the Board of Administration, Tomáz Metello, spoke of the numbers to be announced “the last fiscal year, regardless of the high price of fuel, was an excellent reflexion of world economical warming”, stating its current concern for the sanitary situation in Brazil, and expressing the wish that the Brazilian government may quickly solve the crisis of the “dengue” mosquito that is affecting the sale of touristic packs in the Brazilian markets.

The Chairman of the Board of Administration of EAA, Tomáz Metello, also announced that his company signed a long term contract with the Libyan company Afriqiyah Airways to place in Tripoli a Boeing 757-200 plane with the goal of ensuring connections from the Libyan capital to Europe and other African countries. This equipment will be accompanied by fifty highly qualified Portuguese technicians. Tomás Metello mentioned that the factors that ensured the signing of this contract were “the full satisfaction of the client in previous agreements, the prestige euroAtlantic enjoys in Libya”, and stressed that “with this exporting of services EAA is contributing to the equilibrium of our commercial balance for that country”. euroAtlantic was used during the recent State visit of President Khadafi to Spain. Tomás Metello’s and GP’s company ensures a standard and an excellence of product that are easily adaptable to the sharing of the compromise of the contracting company to its final consumers.

euroAtlantic airways has always presented positive results, holding a consolidated position in its business area. EAA was once again quoted, this year, by the magazine Exame “500 Maiores & Melhores” [Bigger & Better 500] in first place in the list of Portuguese companies that presented the best financial results in the transportation segment.
