

> euroAtlantic wishes to list on the London stock exchange in 2008

euroAtlantic, the air company led by Tomaz Metello, intends to gain listing on the London stock exchange during the first quarter of 2008, projecting the dispersal of around 25% of the capital in the city according to Wednesday's edition of the Jornal de Negócios.

The air company which was even regarded as a potential purchaser of Air Luxor and as a participant in the race for Varig, obtained a profit of 5.9 million euros in 2005, an amount which multiplied almost fivefold the 1.2 million obtained in 2004. The revenue of the air company attained 108 million euros, 19% more than that registered in 2004 which stood at 91 million. Tomaz Metello, the company chairman, attributed this positive evolution of the financial indicators to the growth in the ACMI business (rental of aircraft with crews) and to charters. According to Tomaz Metello at a press conference where he disclosed results, the strategy is to «develop markets where this type of traffic exists».
