2010 Was Marked by great milestones for euroAtlantic

n November 15th, 2019 euroAtlantic airways was bought by I-Jet Aviation PT, a consortium formed by businessman Abed El Jaouni and the investment firm Njord Partners. The newly formed I-Jet Aviation PT announced on that date that the successful acquisition of euroAtlantic airways was fully funded by I-Jet Aviation PT. This was the latest in a series of recent strategic growth moves by the company to meet the growing demand for ACMI and charters aviation services.

The new Chairman of the Board of Directors Abed El Jaouni has ambitious plans for the company and plans to provide it and the

existing management team with all the financial and operational support needed to fulfill those plans. EuroAtlantic airways' founder Tomaz Metello will remain, but as a non-executive member of the I-Jet Aviation PT Board of Directors.

Back In 2018, when our company celebrated its 25th year of existence, our fleet was reinforced with the acquisition of three more Boeing 767-300ER. In August that year, the first of the three aircrafts bought received its certification from ANAC, and the other two finished their

certification process at the end of 2019's first quarter. In addition to the aircraft acquisition, our company also began a cabin renewal process on two of the new airplanes. The first was concluded in 2019, and the second will be finished in 2020 with a new economic class seats, new state of art executive lie flat chairs as well as a new inflight enternainment system with films, TV series and games. Our Maintenance and Compliance departments played a fundamental role in this process with the certification of all the new aircrafts.

Also in the end of 2019 our company won the prize of Breakthrough of the Year in the Innovation & Technology category at the Air Convention Awards 2019 with our APP FOOT, developed inhouse by our IT Department. In the same year, we were also nominated - for the first time - as Europe's Leading Charter Airline and - for the seventh time - as World's Leading Charter Airline. As CEO of euroAtlantic airways, I reiterate my proud appreciation of the company's employees for their commitment and steadfast dedication. which contributed significantly to the company's success and ongoing improvement. I'd also like to acknowledge our customers, suppliers and financial institutions for their trust in and preference for our airline.

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

he company's main business is providing capacity solutions for other airlines. It provides charter services, wet leases and ad hoc flights from anywhere to several places in Europe and to the rest of the world, as well as operational support services. In addition, euroAtlantic airways offers regular weekly flights connecting Lisbon to São Tomé and Principe and Guinea Bissau.

We believe that euroAtlantic's success is the reflection of our Client's own success, so meeting the rising expectations of our customers remains central to our strategy of transforming euroAtlantic airways into one of the world's leading global scheduled and non-scheduled airlines.

Funded in August 25, 1993, with the initial name of Air Zarco, by Tomaz Metello, former Chairman



of the Board of Directors and sole owner of euroAtlantic airways. The company's business was the renting of airplanes to other airlines under wet leasing contracts. At the time, Tomaz

Metello decided to adopt the trade name of Air Madeira. Under the management of its founder and guided by an innovative vision, Air Madeira prospered. Starting out initially with a Lockheed L-1011 Tristar purchased from TAP Portugal, soon two more aircrafts joined the fleet – a B757 and a B737-200 – to meet the demands of the Canada route, and to take Portuguese tourists to Cuba, the Dominican Republic, Spain and Greece.

In 1999, bureaucratic issues dictated that Air Zarco replace the Air Madeira brand. However, the name did not make it in the international market and on 17 May 2000 the name euroAtlantic airways - SA was finally adopted. This same year, the company managed to launch the first international charter flight to the Brazilian Northeast – to João Pessoa – and the IATA winter was as successful both in terms of price and hours as the summer.



euroAtlanticargo

In 2009, euroAtlantic airways made the strategic decision to establish an air cargo industry within the company, becoming the first airline in the world to turn a Boeing 767-300ER passenger aircraft into a cargo plane, for B767-300SF (Special Freighter). After much research into the performance of this aircraft market, the results were positive and cost effective. The capabilities of this B767-300SF Cargo, for the import and export sector of markets such as Portugal, Angola, Brazil and the CPLP countries. were generally very attractive, having very interesting indicators. as for the import and for the export sector.



Over the years, euroAtlantic airways set several other landmarks. In 1997 it began chartering airplanes to airlines from several Muslim countries – such as Nigeria, India, Indonesia, and Malaysia – to send pilgrims to Mecca during the annual pilgrimage began. The operations were so successful that euroAtlantic has currently a permanent authorization from the Saudi authorities to carry passengers in those operations. In March 1998, we were chosen to organize our first presidential trip to Macau with President Jorge Sampaio, then in office. This was the first of many other presidential and governmental trips. In May 2001, we received our first Boeing 737-300, and later purchased a second one to cover the European routes. Starting in the same year, euroAtlantic airways was selected to make several successful Airline Cruises around the World - all starting and ending in Paris and lasting between 15 to 80 days in a row –, which allowed our company to land on such iconic locations as the Easter Island and as far away as French Polynesia.

In 2003 we negotiated with Varig the shared use of two Boeing 767-800ER, while planning to increase our fleet with four similar aircraft the

next year. In 2004 we acquired a small Mozambican airline, Air Plus, which allowed us to access this African market, while in July of the same year the company became the first Portuguese airline to use a Boeing 767-300ER. In 2005, the company continued its sustained expansion with the leasing of three more Boeing 767-300ER, with two more Boeing 757-200 being added to the fleet in early 2006. Once again euroAtlantic airways was a pioneer company introducing various Boeing models in Portugal, a trend reinforced in 2009 when our Boeing 777-200ER, the largest long-range twin-engine aircraft, was acquired to carry out medium-haul flights.

On November 15th, 2019 euroAtlantic airways was bought by I-Jet Aviation PT, a consortium formed by businessman Abed El Jaouni and the investment firm Njord Partners. The newly formed I-Jet Aviation PT announced on that date that the successful acquisition of euroAtlantic airways was fully funded by I-Jet Aviation PT.

This was the latest in a series of recent strategic growth moves by the company to meet the growing demand for ACMI and charters aviation services. The new Chairman of the Board of Directors Abed El Jaouni has ambitious plans for the company and plans to provide it and the existing management team with all the financial and operational support needed to fulfill those plans. WORLD RECOGNITION

euroAtlantic was nominated for the prestigious "Europa 500" award audited by Dun & Bradstreet, out of 167 million independent companies. This was a Europe's 500 initiative, a platform that each year organizes the "European Growth Summit", where companies and entrepreneurs participate in this category. We were extremely proud to receive this nomination, as it reflects a winning commitment, where, although we had to deal with an enormous economic crisis, we've managed to look forward to new opportunities and investments... and we succeeded.

In 2012 euroAtlantic received a special commendation and compliments sent from several countries around the world after the Department of Transportation (DOT) of the United States formally approved, for the first time in American civil aviation history, the hiring of a plane in this country, in a long-term contract — operated by a foreign company. This authorization - produced in record time with the USA government — is a source of pride for Portugal and for our aerospace industry, because for the first time a company outside the United States has received an authorization to sign such

an important contract. The image, reputation and financial strength of the euroAtlantic airways brand helped open the doors to the largest passenger and cargo traffic generator in the world for a Portuguese company.

From 2013 to 2019, euroAtlantic airways, due to the excellence of the services provided, was nominated for the WTA – World Travel Awards, in the category "Best Charter Airline Company in the World" and was one of the three finalist airline companies. Also in 2019 our company was nominated again for the WTA – World Travel Awards, but in the category "Best Charter Airline Company in Europe" for the first time.

In the end of 2019, euroAtlantic airways won the of the Innovation & Technology award as Breakthrough of the Year, with the APP FOOT in the Air Convention Europe Awards. This exclusive APP was created and developed internally as a support base for sharing and management of all physical documentation required for the flights. This APP was developed with two objectives: to centralize operational information, making it accessible to all Flight Operations departments and to reduce the amount of paper used in the cockpit. Is available through the AppStore, only for the IOS system and has three main characteristics: Checklists, Documents Box and Briefings.

Since 2001, euroAtlantic airways has already completed successfully for TMR eleven Airline Cruises around the World and two transatlantic flights, all starting and ending in Paris, lasting between 15 to 30 days in a row, allowing our company to land on such iconic locations as the Easter Island and as far away as French Polynesia. Previously this flights were performed

with the Air France Concorde quoting a 98% of euroAtlantic airways production contracted abroad.
