



> **Portuguese actors with euroAtlantic at the Lisbon's Tourism Fair**

**About euroAtlantic airways:** the company founded and owned in its majority by it's current **Chairman of the Board and CEO, Tomaz Metello**, was the pioneer of the tourist intercontinental flights to Brasil. **EAA** started on the **20<sup>th</sup>. September, 2000**, operating charter flights to the Northeast, by that time destination João Pessoa (aparaíba) and after a long burocratic process. The **EAA's** fleet is originally american: **one Boeing B777-200ER (Triple Seven)**, the only one in the Iberian Peninsula, **three Boeing 767-300ER** for passengers, **one B767-ER BDSF (Bedek Special Freighter)**, a new **Boeing 737-800** ready to fly, and a **Lockheed Tristar L1011-500**. It must be refered that **EAA** owns the share control of **STP AIRWAYS (37%)**, the national airline of São Tomé and Príncipe.
