



Portuguese company euroAtlantic after Dili returns this Monday to Luanda

Angola's Covid-19 repatriation flights continue

A **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** aircraft with Portuguese registration, **Boeing B767-300ER CS-TKR**, in the crisis of the **new Coronavirus**, will repatriate this Monday from the **4 de Fevereiro Luanda International Airport**, a group of two hundred and sixty (260) Portuguese citizens. The operation is contracted by **ALIVE PORTUGAL**, an operator and travel agency based in Porto, affiliated with **IATA** and **APVAT**, the **Portuguese Association of Travel and Tourism Agencies**.

The **euroAtlantic airways flight MMZ YU642** is scheduled to leave Luanda at **12:50 UTC time**, with an estimated **19:15 UTC time** at **Humberto Delgado International Airport** in Lisbon. **EAA** between Lisbon and Luanda, transports **Air Cargo** to TAP Air Portugal. **EuroAtlantic's Boeing B767-300ER** can carry **4,580 cu ft (ft³)** in the holds and allow a maximum capacity of **184,612 kg at take-off**. **EAA** in the current pandemic phase of **Covid-19**, is maintaining links between capitals of the **CPLP** and allowing the Portuguese people to return home in the world, this weekend repatriated national citizens of Timor-Leste.

About **euroAtlantic airways**, all of its equipment is of American origin, registered with the **National Civil Aviation Authority (ANAC)** operating with **Boeing B777-200ER**, **Boeing B767-300ER**, **Boeing B737-800NG** in **84.5%** of the countries in the World.
