



## **euroAtlantic in the United States repatriates sailors from Carnival Cruise Line**

A plane of **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** with Portuguese registration **Boeing B777-200ER (Triple Seven)**, in the crisis of the **new Coronavirus**, is preparing to repatriate from **Los Angeles International Airport (LAX)**, California, next **10 March, (04:30 UTC)**, a crew of one of **Carnival Cruise Lines'** luxury liners docked at the port of the City of Angels. The destination of **EAA's Triple Seven, flight MMZ YU732** is located in Indonesia, **Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK)** the largest in the metropolitan region of Jakarta. **EAA's** flight is scheduled for a technical stopover at **Ted Stevens International Airport (ANC)** in Anchorage, Alaska, confirming **EuroAtlantic's** extraordinary technical capabilities of operating in **157 countries**, having visited **700 different airports**, covering **83% of countries** in the world.



**euroAtlantic airways** received from **Carnival Cruise (Fleet Medical Operations)** guarantees that all of its crew members targeted for this repatriation are not infected with **Covid-19**, they have all completed a quarantine of more than **14 days** in the United States. For **EAA** this is the fourth repatriation of ships moored in ports in Japan, Thailand and Portugal (**MSC Fantasia**).

**euroAtlantic airways** is pleased to start this operation with an airplane excuse to carry **30 passengers in Business Class** and **293 in Tourist Class**, **Cargo capacity 5,330 cu ft** and a maximum take-off of **294,835 kg** with pleasure, after **Carnival Corporation President Micky Arison**, announced that his flag ships will help with medical care in **Los Angeles**, New York and San Francisco. The ship-owner offered some of the fleet's ships to the **United States government**, to be converted into floating hospitals for patients who are not infected with the pandemic disease, ships from **Carnival Cruise Line, Holland America Line, Princess Cruises** and **P&O Cruises Australia** may be used.
