



## **euroAtlantic airways worldwide on Covid-19 repatriation emergency flights**

### **Portuguese-speaking countries also covered**

The Portuguese company **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** is preparing a repatriation operation for Portuguese citizens that should take place next **March 28 (Saturday)** from the **4 de Fevereiro International Airport** in Luanda. The **EAA flight (YU652)** is expected to leave the capital of Angola at **13:00 local time**, expected arrival at Lisbon Humberto Delgado Airport at **19:00 local time**.

**euroAtlantic airways** on this repatriation flight, carried out in **Boeing B767-300ER**, between Lisbon and Luanda, will transport **16,509 tons of Cargo to TAP Portugal**.

Yesterday, **euroAtlantic airways**, also on **Boeing B767-300ER**, repatriated citizens (Slovak and Hungarian) between **Washington Dulles International Airport** in Washington (**USA**) and **Bratislava-M International Airport. R.** that serves the capital Slovakia.

**euroAtlantic airways** is preparing new repatriation flights, some of which will come from African Portuguese Speaking Countries (**PALOP**).
