



## euroAtlantic shows Portuguese flag in Barbados repatriating sailors from the Carnival Cruise Line

### a long flight from Little Britain from the Caribbean to Indonesia between Southeast Asia and Australia

A euroAtlantic airways (EAA) Boeing B767-300ER plane in the current crisis of the new Coronavirus, landed in Barbados at Sir Grantley Adams International Airport (BGY), (flight MMZ-YU653), which serves the capital Bridgetown. The euroAtlantic stopover in the former British colony, were it not for the reason of taking yet another Carnival Cruise Lines repatriation flight, it would allow Portuguese seafarers to learn a little about the history of the former British colony, a postcard with white sand beaches, facing the Caribbean Sea, discovered in 1511 by Spaniards and who from 1536 crew members of Portuguese ships en route to Brazil, started to visit.

euroAtlantic airways shows its logo again with the Carnival Cruise Line, part of Carnival Corporation & pic, an Anglo-American cruise multinational, formed by 10 companies, such as Holland America Line, Princess Cruises in the United States, P&O Cruises and Cunard Line in the United Kingdom, AIDA Cruises in Germany, Costa Crociere in Italy, extending its network of companies to Spain and Australia. The entire euroAtlantic fleet is registered with the National Air Authority and in the current Covid-19 pandemic it has been available to serve Portugal's strategic capabilities, in need of repatriation or air cargo transportation, avoiding resources to external dependencies.

The euroAtlantic airways flight (MMZ-YU654) leaves Barbados on May 2 at 2:00 pm (UTC) in the direction of Lisbon Humberto Delgado Airport (LIS), where it should land at 9:05 pm (UTC). After rotation in Portugal, he will make a technical stop at the Tbilisi International Airport (TBS) in Georgia, at 03:50 (UTC time on May 3) and plans to

estimate the final destination in Indonesia at **Soekarno-Hatta International Airport (CGK)** serving the metropolitan region of Jakarta, also the destination of the previous *Staff Repatriation Flight of Carnival Cruise Lines* carried out by **EAA** from Los Angeles, United States.

**euroAtlantic airways** has received from **Carnival Cruise (Fleet Medical Operations)** which operates **27 vessels**, with around **40,000 crew members**, guarantees that all staff targeted for repatriation are not infected with **Covid-19**, having already completed quarantines of more than **14 days**. For **EAA** this is the **fifth repatriation of ships** docked in ports in Japan, Thailand, United States and Portugal (**MSC Fantasia**).
