



euroAtlantic's Portuguese plane flies from Angola to Portugal with European citizens

all euroAtlantic airplanes are also being occupied by medical cargo

A Portuguese plane from **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** with a national flag, **Boeing B767-300ER**, arrives in Lisbon next **Wednesday 13 May** at **Humberto Delgado International Airport (LIS)**, coming from **Luanda's 4 de Fevereiro International Airport (LAD)**. The extraordinary **flight MMZ-YU612** in the current state of the **Covid-19** pandemic, was contracted by **Tour Operator Sonhando (Dreaming)**, leaves Angola at **23:00 (local time)** on **May 12** at **23:00 (local time)**. In addition to being promoted on the **SONHANDO** website (www.sonhando.pt) and by a network of travel agencies affiliated with **APAVT**, which are associated with branches of Angolan agencies, **ZEPA ABREU, ATLANTIDA, TRAVELGEST, REALVITUR ANGOLA**.

The same **euroAtlantic airways** plane, before this operation for **SONHANDO**, had landed hours earlier at **Luanda Airport (LAD)**, coming from **São Paulo-Guarulhos Airport (GRU)** in Brazil, having performed a second humanitarian flight, hired by the company Angolan **BestFly**, in the same week that another **Boeing B767-300ER** from the **euroAtlantic** fleet arrived in Lisbon, coming from Bangalore in southern India, with a load of **15 tons of sanitary gloves**. In addition to serving Portugal in the current pandemic of the **new Coronavirus**, **EAA** is supporting other Portuguese-speaking countries (**CPLP**) in terms of air capacity needs, in addition to their economies. **EAA** refers, as already reported, intends to expand its activities to Brazil, with this flight to Angola similar to the first, translated into support for its exports.
