



euroAtlantic's Portuguese plane returns to repatriate sailors from the Carnival Cruise Line

Indian sailors have already left Spain to fly home to India

A Portuguese plane from **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** taking off to **Seville's San Pablo Airport (SVQ)**, with staff members from one of the **Carnival Cruise Lines'** dockers, docked at Andalusian ports, bound for **Chhatrapati Shivaji Airport (BOM)** in Bombay, where Portuguese companies do not operate. Previously the domestic terminal was called by '**Santa Cruz**' many of the passengers boarded, as the final destination Goa, during an intercontinental call, listening to words that are still familiar.



euroAtlantic airways is once again the choice of **Carnival Cruise Line**, integrated in **Carnival Corporation & pic**, an Anglo-American cruise multinational, formed by **10** companies, such as **Holland America Line**, **Princess Cruises** in the United States, **P&O**

Cruises and **Cunard Line** in the United Kingdom, **AIDA Cruises** in Germany, **Costa Crociere** in Italy, extending its network to Spain and Australia.

euroAtlantic airways has received from **Carnival Cruise (Fleet Medical Operations)** which operates **27 vessels**, with around **40,000 crew members**, guarantees that all staff targeted for repatriation are not infected with **COVID-19**, having already completed quarantines of more than **14 days**. For **EAA** this is the **sixth repatriation** of ships at berth in ports in Japan, Thailand, United States, Spain and Portugal (MSC Fantasia).
