



## **euroAtlantic with Guiné Tours reconnects Lisbon to Bissau on a humanitarian flight**

**Portuguese plane carries the delegation of the Prime Minister of Guinea-Bissau Nuno Nabiam**

**Air connections from Portugal to African Portuguese-Speaking Countries remain assured**

**euroAtlantic airways (EAA)**, a historic brand in the heart of Guinean consumers since **2000** and **2001**, when the Portuguese company started operations in Guinea-Bissau, subsequently interrupted, until **2014**, when **TAP Air Portugal**, suspended connections between the two countries, depriving Guinea-Bissau of direct flights to Europe, with the support of the **Government of the Republic of Guiné-Bissau**, in an initiative by the **GUINÉ TOURS** agency owned by Guinean **businessman Francisco Conduto Pina**, to be held on **12 July ( Sunday)**, a new special charter connection between the two **States of the Community of Portuguese Speaking Countries (CPLP)**. The operation in the current crisis situation, with closed air borders, also has the support of the **Embassy of Guinea-Bissau in Portugal** and the Portuguese bilateral diplomacy in Bissau. The euroAtlantic airways flight (**MMZ-YU671**) made by the **Boeing B767-300ER CS-TKR** with Portuguese flag, has announced departure from **Lisbon Humberto Delgado Airport (LIS)**, at **08:00 (UTC) 09:00 local time**, takes on board the delegation of the **Prime Minister of Guinea-Bissau, Engineer** (with Aeronautical training), **Nuno Gomes Nabiam (53)** in office since February **28, 2020**, plans to estimate **Oswaldo Vieira Airport (OXB)** in the capital Bissau, at **12:15 (UTC hours)**, also carries tons of Sanitary Cargo, used to combat **COVID-19** and other essential goods. The return to Lisbon (**Flight MMZ-YU672**) is scheduled to leave at **2:00 pm (UTC time)** and estimates the Portuguese capital at **18:20 (UTC) 19:20 local time**.

**Guiné Tours**, said **businessman Conduto Pina**, is committed to support the recovery of tourism in Guinea-Bissau, post-pandemic of the **new Coronavirus**, betting on the wealth of the tourist main point of Bissau, Bijagós. Off the continent in the Bijagós archipelago, a natural paradise in the middle of the Atlantic with a four (**4**) hour flight from Europe, saltwater hippos, dolphins and giant turtles live. High season at island resorts opens in **October | November**, with the intention of **Guiné Tours**, if conditions are met, launch with **euroAtlantic** and support from Portuguese Tour Operators and Travel Agents, if conditions are met, a special "**New Year's Eve**" program later this year, which attaches

to reveal the secrets of tasting the best of the cashews, taste the best oysters and prawns in the world or delicious tropical mangoes.

**About euroAtlantic airways and Guinea-Bissau;** the portuguese company offers in this extraordinary flight departing from Europe, a benefit that reflects an extraordinary savings in the passengers wallets, being able to carry **two** hold bags with **23 kg** of luggage each, in addition to a piece with **05 kg** in the cabin (total **61 kg**) . **EAA** hopes to soon be able to resume regular connections between Lisbon and Bissau. **EAA** continues to invest in the country's potential in the segment of tourism and underlying products, homesickness, safaris, hunting and sport fishing. The main point of Bissau, Bijagós, presents an excellent hotel park, such as the kindness of the people, the art of welcoming people, combined with a gastronomy where the sea products predominate, the calm and tranquility in a lush green, despite some political instability, that went unnoticed by the visitor, were contributing to the increase in revenues and benefiting the country's economy.
