



before Guinea-Bissau skies open euroAtlantic operates COVID-19 flight to Sagres

euroAtlantic airways 20 Years in the heart of Guinea-Bissau consumers

The Portuguese company **euroAtlantic airways (EAA)** has been present in Guinea-Bissau since **2000** and **2001** and later since **2014** on an uninterrupted basis, when the suspension of **TAP AIR PORTUGAL** flights deprived the country of the **Official Portuguese Language** of direct air connections to Europe, with the support of the Authorities and **Government of the Republic of Guinea-Bissau**, in an initiative of the **SAGRES travel and tourism agency** in Bissau, it will hold on July 26 (Sunday), a new special charter connection to Guinea-Bissau. **EAA's** operation in the current crisis situation of the **new Coronavirus**, still with closed air borders, is supported by Guinea-Bissau's bilateral diplomacy in Portugal and Portuguese diplomacy in Bissau.

The **Director of SAGRES, Carla Gomes**, elected **euroAtlantic** as a partner in this operation because the company is a brand in the heart of Guinea-Bissau. The capacity of **EAA** aircraft allows the country to receive larger amounts of Air Cargo, allows passengers to travel with **two hold bags with 30 kg of luggage** each, in addition to a piece up to **05 kg in the cabin (total 65 kg)**, an extraordinary savings for the Guinean consumer. **EAA** regularly also carries urns of members of Guinean society who have died in Portugal, who wish to be buried in the motherland. **EAA** is a symbol in the affective and cultural relationship between two sister peoples of the **CPLP** with the same language and common history.

The **euroAtlantic airways** flight **MMZ-YU671**, carried out with the **Boeing B767-300ER CS-TKR** of the national fleet, has an announced departure from **Lisbon Humberto Delgado Airport (LIS)**, at **09:00 (UTC) 10:00 hours** local time, predicted to estimate the **Oswaldo Vieira Airport (OXB)** in Bissau, at **13:15 (UTC time)**. The return to Portugal of flight **MMZ-YU672** is scheduled for the same day, it is estimated that **Lisbon Airport** will be estimated at **19:05 (UTC) 20:05 local time**.

euroAtlantic airways expects to resume regular flights between Lisbon and Bissau soon, continues to invest in the country's potential for tourism about four (**4**) hours from Europe and the underlying products, supporting its economy and development. The Bissau axis, Bijagós archipelago, with an excellent hotel park and sanctuary islands of green turtles and saltwater hippos, combined with an art of welcoming people, gastronomy where sea products prevail, tranquility, despite some political instability, which went unnoticed by the visitor, were increasing revenues and benefiting the economy of the approximately **1,792,338** inhabitants of the country.
